



1. The format of the drawing is not critical. The more details and dimension you provide, the better.
2. NRE stands for non-recurring Engineering. This is a one-time investment that does not need to be paid again.
3. Tooling/NRE Investment funds are to be paid in advance to begin the building of samples.
4. Counter Drawing must be signed off by customer before the building of samples can begin.
5. Lead time is based on quote from Focus Display (Lead time is subject to change without notice).
6. Approval Form, also called the Acceptance Sign Off Form, notifies Focus Display that the samples meet the customer's requirements.
